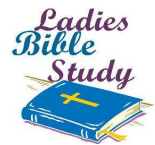

Peoples Bank has offered us a 3.25% variable rate for 7 years with a rate ceiling of 7%. We currently have a 6.15% interest only rate. Using an amortization schedule we will payoff the mortgage in 12 years or less. We have \$7,600 a month in the budget and our first payment would be \$4,487 in interest and the difference of \$3,113 would go toward principal. If we take \$7,000 from HIW each month and pay toward principal, we would be paying a little over \$10,000 toward principal each month. And the interest payment will decrease each month and the principal payment then will increase each month, therefore paying down the loan quicker. The total cost of this loan adjustment will cost the church \$1,000. Peoples Bank is paying the remainder of the fees for the appraisal, attorney, title work and loan closing. All other terms and conditions of our original loan agreement will remain the same.
